

Rules for Low-Net Tournament on JUNE 4th, 2018

- 1. All putts must be played “into the cup.”**
- 2. 6” Bump permitted.**
- 3. Play “ready golf.”**
- 4. Relief is permitted without penalty for the following conditions: heavily watered or mulched areas, and for “ground under repair conditions” such as bare and/or seeded areas. Inform your playing partners, then lift your ball and place it at the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole.**
- 5. All lakes and boundary fences including the driving range, parking lot, and practice putting greens are to be treated as Lateral Water Hazards. You may drop your ball two club lengths from point of entry with one stroke penalty.**
- 6. A ball that goes through a boundary fence including driving range is considered a defective fence and is dropped two club lengths - no penalty.**
- 7. If a ball is lost, drop another ball where you and the others in your group believe the ball should be and take a one stroke penalty. (There is no “stroke and distance” penalty.)**
- 8. You may move the ball to a grass area, NO Closer to the Hole, for Bare or Punched fairways or rough areas (Considered Ground Under Repair)**
- 9. Maximum Strokes double par plus one.**
